My interest in sports injuries also stems from my time as a softball player at Columbia University during my undergraduate education. As a native of Maryland, I was happy to return to the Mid-Atlantic following fellowship training to join OASD to become the first fellowship trained shoulder and elbow surgeon in southern Delaware.

I have been an instructor at courses in techniques of rotator cuff repair, authored several book chapters and articles, as well as review articles for the Journal of Shoulder and Elbow Surgery.
